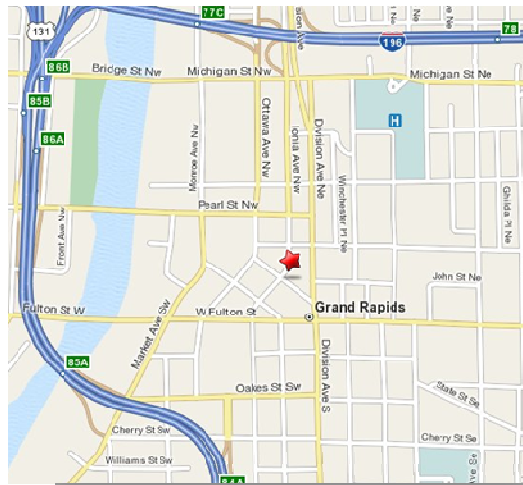

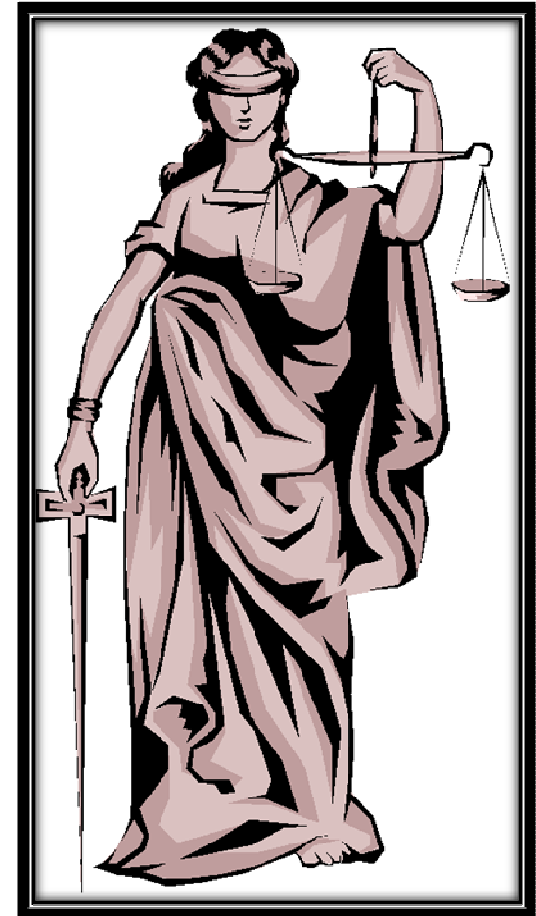

## Drug or Metabolite cutoff levels at the 61<sup>st</sup> District Court

Drug or Metabolite	Cutoff Level (nanograms(ng)/mL)
Marijuana	50
Cocaine metabolite	300
Opiate	300
Amphetamines	1000
Oxycodone	100
Barbiturates	200
Methadone	300
Ecstasy	500
Alcohol (EtG)	500
Benzodiazepines	200
Heroin metabolite	10

\*The lab uses an instrument based method for testing.

### Pricing Options

Drug test	Cost
*3-panel	\$15.00
5-panel	\$20.00
PBT	\$2.00
Additional tests (excluding EtG)	\$4.00
EtG only	\$15.00
**EtG with 3- or 5-panel test	\$5.00

\*3-panel test includes the same drug screens as the 5-panel test; however, validity tests are not included.

\*\* In addition to the cost of the 3- or 5-panel test

**Participants that are responsible for payments of test must pay in cash upon sign-in.**

The 5-panel drug test is the most preferred protocol for testing because it includes 3 popular drugs of abuse and 2 validity tests.

### The 5-panel test includes:

- ✓ **THC**
- ✓ **Cocaine**
- ✓ **Opiates**
- ✓ **Validity Tests** – used to ensure the integrity of the sample, and to ensure there are no adulterants
  - **Specific Gravity** – This test helps evaluate the participants' fluid balance and urine concentration.
    - ❖ This validity test measures the concentration of solids dissolved in the urine, and possible substitution (adulterants).
  - **Creatinine** – Creatinine is removed from the body entirely by the kidneys.
    - ❖ Consuming excessive fluids, and/or water, causes the body to produce urine with creatinine levels below the acceptable range (dilute samples).

In addition to the 5-panel test, the 61<sup>st</sup> District Court Drug Lab also has the ability to conduct the following tests:

- ✓ **EtG**
- ✓ **Amphetamines**
- ✓ **Ecstasy**
- ✓ **Oxycodone**
- ✓ **Barbiturates**
- ✓ **Methadone**
- ✓ **Benzodiazepines**
- ✓ **Heroin Metabolite**

### Preliminary Breath Test (PBT)

### EtG

An EtG test is a biomarker test that detects the presence of Ethyl Glucuronide in urine samples. This test is used to monitor alcohol consumption for individuals that are legally prohibited from drinking alcohol by the justice system.

The EtG test can show if alcohol has been consumed within the past 72 hours.

The 61<sup>st</sup> District Court is the only facility in West Michigan that offers the EtG test.
